My name is Enda Lavelle and I am running as an Independent Community Candidate in the forthcoming local elections.


I am asking you for your vote and, in turn, I promise you I will bring something new, something fresh, something of value, to political representation in this electoral area.

Employment

Jobs are a huge issue at the moment. The local economy is suffering. If we are to keep young people at home, we must think

the region, and that is why I will work closely with youth organisations to develop these facilities further. As a special priority, I will ensure facilities also cater for young people with special needs.




Schools
